By time you have gotten to the 31st book of the series I am sure you must have a good idea about the level of violence regardless of the book only being rated Teen. Just in case you are reading this review before any other book in the series you should know it is action oriented and often involves weapons used by soul

reapers so it might not be appropriate for all audiences.

Coming face to face with Ulquiorra, Ichigo is told what happened to Rukia in the last volume of the series and the truth about why Orihime is now in Hueco Mondo. Ichigo must now fight and learn what the extent of his power can achieve but will it be enough? You should read to see the answer for yourself. :)

In the mean time Orihime is being targeted while Ulquiorra is preoccupied so she must survive as best as she can until help can arrive. The person that comes to assist her might be a bit of a surprise though for those that have been reading the series (and not watching the anime.)

Renji in the mean time is challenging the arrancar Szayelaporro Granz who excels in scientific reasoning and skill. Things seem bleak until Uryu shows up and joins the fray. It seems it is only the beginning of the fight though so look forward to seeing this monster in the future.

These battles seem to be getting shorter and shorter, which doesn't seem like the Bleach that I knew from the beginning. Ichigo quickly takes care of Ulquiorra, which gives them about 15 seconds of peace, (which COULD have been used to running away) but Ulquiorra comes out of the smoke ready to kill Ichigo.

I think it was really cute how Ichigo smiled at Nel, especially because she was crying over him. Nel seemed to almost disappear while Ichigo was beat up, and before that he figured out that Ulquiorra was actually the 4th strongest Espada, instead of the strongest. Grimmjow saves Orihime from being beaten to a pulp, and brings her to Ichigo to heal him for a fair battle. (After sending Ulquiorra away with a Caja De Negación OF COURSE).

I don't really understand if Orihime healed the people who beat her up, or took part of one and added it to the other injured person to heal them, or...? I'm not sure, it seemed very unclear to me.

Uryû comes to Renji's rescue, which brings the wimpy Pesche and Dondochakka together once more. Uryû manages to near-kill Szayelaporro with one of his Quincy tricks, and the help of Renji being the distraction, but their super psycho pink-haired enemy, (that wasn't necessarily an insult) eats one of his comrades and heals himself, leaving them baffled and probably horrified too. He said he was going to change his clothing (O~o) and give them time to figure out a plan. If they're smart, they will run away to find Orihime, (although she's with Ichigo).

What's up with all this nonsense that Ichigo is not himself? Obviously his spiritual pressure might be a little different from before because he's now Hollowfied, (which he's probably doing too often) but Orihime keeps flipping everytime he fights. This never happened in the volume, I'm just saying that for the preview.
