I adored Tony, he was such a quiet, steady, strong presence and he has the goods that make a reader swoon!

Randa Whitmore has come to the hotel with a purpose, to win her father's approval. Working undercover, or so she thinks, she wasn't very good at it, she's immediately taken with Tony. These two set my heart a flutter. There was no real drama in their relationship, even after Randa reveals her real purpose for coming to the hotel. No fighting, they just come to an understanding. It's a slow build, and friendship finds its way to love. I enjoyed getting to know them first, before they moved forward in their relationship. The chemistry between Tony and Randa is a slow burn, it simmers until it boils over, and then it's tender, passionate and a little bittersweet.

Willodean, owner of the Rock'n'Rolla, is like a fairy godmother. After having a rough start herself early on in life, she takes in employees who are either down on their luck or are having a hard time adjusting to life. She makes it her mission to guide them along, through experience and advice. She's also financially stable and

makes sure they are too. Misty, the resident princess blood hound, and Willodean's dog, lends comfort when needed, doesn't judge, and is just looking for someone to fuss over her. She is fast becoming one of my favorite characters in the series, and I love reading about her as much as everyone else.

Some of the characters from *Stuck On You* make an appearance, and I especially enjoyed seeing KT again, when he comes to lend a hand at the hotel. Ever funny and charming, I hope we get read more about KT and Laura in the books to come.

This was such an enjoyable, pleasant read. It's sweet, witty, angst-free, and has an easy flow to it. Randa was delightful, realizing that her position as only daughter and youngest in the family had set her up for a shallow and meaningless (to her) life of 'supporting' your man, being gorgeous and thin and not working an outside job is not for her. Determined to be recognized, she works hard at being the best in her industry, just to get some recognition and respect.

Tony is a former foster child and retired Marine, with deep wounds of his own, including PTSD. In actual fact, Tony has many techniques to keep his anxiety at bay –but his love for books, ALL kinds of books in all genres, and his trip to his favorite book store with Randa was possibly the best scene (for me) in the whole book. What more could a girl ask for than a handsome man who reads – and thinks you are pretty special?

As the two get closer, Randa is unable to keep lying, or omitting, the truth of her visit to Tony, and later to the owner Willodean.
