I hate to say it, but this book is DREADFUL (Capitals totally intended!). The success of these books hinge on you liking the female lead and I hated this girl. She was weak and spineless and manipulative and totally clueless.

The other issue I have is that current M&B authors all seem to be trying to outdo each other with these crazy outlandish storylines. They have forgotten the art and elegance of simplicity.
