Lianna Landry was just a job, but one he didn't expect to be attracted to. She's a drug addict, has been actress given a second chance at re-animating her career. The career she threw away on booze and drugs. A child actress that made bad decisions. Tuck is hired by the studio to retrieve her when she doesn't show up for work one day. He finds her in the worst possible place. One that just walking out of isn't going to be easy, and actually leads to car chases, shootings, kidnapping, and eventually redemption.
