I would have given this book a 3.5 rating because I really enjoyed the first half a lot, but then kind of dropped out of the story when the second "suit" comes into play. I found the transition between the two to come too quickly. Also the last few chapters seem to have been written rapidly and missed being revised before they got published: "She took his hands in his." (p.96, according to my Kobo Mini reader). No big deal, but annoying.

The story is well written and quite plausible for its first half. I was into it. But when the superhero meets his match, it gets a bit less credible. And what is it with that lady in the wheelchair...? I was expecting something to happen with that character, but no....

Also, I would have thought the author would have set up the plate for the sequel to this story (Black Onyx Recharged) but missed to do so. In my opinion, Mr. Methos would have assured himself of some readers wanting to read more about his superhero.

Nonetheless, comic books fans will enjoy this story, even without the cartoon images.
