Chloe is a physical therapist whose company works with the football team. She does not like working with football players due to a bad experience but she loves her job. Austin is a player who was injured and needs PT to get back in the game. He immediately takes a liking to Chloe and resolves to get her in his bed. I liked Chloe and Austin on the surface. The secret with Austin made me like him more. One thing I hate is in books when people give someone a nickname and that person constantly tells them to stop and they don't. In this case, Austin calls Chloe doc even though she's not a doctor. It's just a pet peeve of mine and made Austin seem annoying to me. I thought when Chloe found out Austin's secret they would begin a friendship and the relationship would grow from there. All around it was just okay for me. Didn't stand out and wouldn't read again but it was a take it or leave it kind of book for me.

My issues with the story were numerous:

- First, this felt incomplete despite the fact the blurb says it's a full length standalone novel. It ended at about 37%.
 - I had a hard time feeling sympathy for Chloe after the photo scandal. She'd been down this road before, didn't learn any lessons and still went ahead and pursued a relationship with a client. You reap what you sow.
 - We're introduced to his daughter and the baby momma, but we are never really shown the dynamic. There's a lot of telling, but no showing. And that makes for a shallow read.
 - In the last chapter we're told that Chloe met with the baby mama, but what happened? Why was this even necessary?
 - We know Roger is an a-hole, but we don't get to see the revenge, so it wasn't as satisfying.
 - What makes their relationship except for the fact that they're hot for each other?
