Cold Blood is an excellent example of the MC genre. Justice is part of the Four Horsemen MC, but he's been put on a temporary suspension so he can get his life together. He's suffering from extreme PTSD from his time in Afghanistan while serving as a Navy SEAL, and the nightmares won't let him sleep. So he smokes out a lot to deal with the memories that won't leave his mind. Etta is the social worker that he apparently met in an earlier story (I haven't read any of the other previous stories in the series). The two have a strong attraction, but she's intent on keeping him out.

When she needs help dealing with her abusive ex husband who just got out of prison, though, Justice is there for her, and slowly the two give into their attraction. Justice to me is the real star of *Cold Blood*. He's damaged for sure, but he's got such a huge heart and when he loves, he loves hard, and protects those he loves. Reading the two of them falling in love, dealing with their pasts, watching them slowly helping each other heal, is such an engaging experience.
