Sixth in the super cool My Sister the Vampire series, *Love Bites* has always been one of my favourites, if not **the** favourite. It's certainly the one I've re-read most (although *Star Style* and *Date with Destiny* come close), which is saying something, I'm telling you. It seems so amazing that even on the millionth time reading the book, I'm still gasping at the revelations, laughing at the jokes and grinning at the end.

This book is the first proper change of scenery in the series so far, as Ivy and Olivia head off to the majestic Transylvania to meet their long-lost grandparents, who are, by the way, Count and Countess! The twins are even lucky enough to spend time with the Transylvanian royal family, but Valentine's Day approaches, there are family feuds to fix and love lives to unmuddle. There's only one pair of twins for the job, but will everything come together on time?
