While this book can be considered a stand-alone, if you read the two previous books, Tug of War and Objective, you should be very happy with the characters featured. At least I was. Because this book features two people that never got their HEA and total deserve one.

My heart hurt for Sawyer in Tug of War. While his physical description makes me think of a bad ass, his character is all heart. He loves freely and he loves hard. Although not her actual Dad, he treats Allie as if she is his own. He's the model father every kid should have. And it's taken him time to recover from the heartache Clara caused in moving on.

This book is primarily told from Sawyer's POV. I absolutely loved his inner monologue. He's a bit of a goof and I LOL'd at some of the moments his berates his own behavior.
