Henley Hendrix thought she had been through all the bad life had in store for her and was finally on the right path. Just when things were going well in her career and love life, everything is ripped away and despite her best efforts, she can't seem to find her footing again. The harder she tries, the more she seems to loose until Henley finds herself going down a path that will lead her to a very dark place. Once on that path, will she be able to find her way back?

First off, let me say that this is not a standalone. If you have not read Guitar Face, you need to read that book before reading this one. This book...it is hard to write a review without giving away all the plot points so let me just say that this book (better than the first IMO) is emotional and heartbreaking from start to finish.
