This short story is not a stand-alone; it is intended as the Epilogue to *Breathe*, published in 2010. We get to revisit Jay and Linc who have just moved into a new house, one they are renting and planning to buy someday together. The author made a few references to the previous story, enough to jog my memory, but not a lot, so don't read this if you haven't read *Breathe*. If you have read *Breathe*, this is a must read and it would be good to do so before you start this. It's quite short, and covers about 24 hours in their lives--enough time to christen their kitchen table, and not with food!

There is a short segment in which we hear Jay's thoughts about the future, a future that is filled with possibilities, including the purchase of the house with Linc, complete with porch swing to allow them a private area for quiet reflection at the end of the day. Jay is back in college, Linc is working full time, and their lives are filled with hope.

On the second day of the story, we visit Linc's sister Nancy and her kids who have recovered from the fire and are moving into a new home. There's hope for a happy future for them as well.

As the story ends, Linc reflects on his appreciation of the gifts he's been given. All in all it's a nice satisfying story that serves to wrap up the ending of *Breathe* with a very special bow.
