Thirty years ago, after the breakdown of an oil negotiation, the President of the United States decided that all people born with unusual abilities, which he would now refer to as "the condition", would be locked away from the general public where they couldn't harm others. Parents and loved ones of these people, most of whom were children, were forced to turn them in upon penalty of death. Formed to keep the institutions secure, the Committee for the Protection of a Free Society now rules these institutions with an iron fist.

The granddaughter of one the Committee members, Addison Wade has lived her life wary of the institutions and all they represent. A woman of secrets, she is forced to turn to Safe Dawn, one of the facilities designed to hold conditioned people, when her nephew is kidnapped and, despite her best efforts, cannot be recovered. She knows the last thing anyone in 'Safe Dawn' will want to do is to help a Wade with any problems, but she is desperate and out of options.

Spencer Lewis is famous for being the premier conditioned 'locator.' There's no one he can't find and he has a soft spot for missing children. But, Spencer has been through a trauma and locating Jeremy Wade may be dangerous both to himself and to those around him. In addition, he takes one look at ice cold Addison Wade and wants nothing more than to knock her down a peg. Never having turned down an opportunity to help a child, he reluctantly agrees to help recover Jeremy.

In a world where nothing is as it seems and every person they encounter has his own agenda, Addison and Spencer will find that the only people they can trust are each other. But how can anyone fall in love living in a world that wants you dead just for being born?

She has learned to keep her abilities at bay and not let her temper get the best of her for fear of being locked up with all the other conditioned people in Safe Dawn. When her nephew is kidnapped, she is forced to turn to one of the conditioned inside Safe Dawn, though she knows no one will want to help a Wade because of her grandfather.

Spencer is a famous conditioned locator. He can mentally go into the dark zone and find the essence that a person leaves behind and track them when most people can't. When he goes through a trauma of losing someone close to him, he doesn't know if he can do his job without endangering himself in the process. This book was a really neat twist on the concept of a romance novel, because it brought in a supernatural element that made the story around the steaminess really captivating. It felt like X-Men turned into an NC-17 movie,

Addison has hidden her Condition her entire life. Born into an incredibly wealthy and powerful family, she knows her life depends on no one finding out what she is. Her father taught her how to keep it under control so that no one would find out she was one of "them", the freaks that her own grandfather has locked away to protect the public. But when the beloved nephew she promised her dying sister she'd protect is kidnapped, Addison is desperate enough to risk exposing herself in order to find him. She enters Safe Dawn, one of the institutions where people like her are held, in the hopes that infamous locator Spencer Lewis will use his powers to help her. What she didn't expect was the hard-bodied gorgeous blonde specimen that walked into the room, and right away she knows working with him is going to be a problem. Spencer, a resident of the institution for most of his life, doesn't know what to make of the beautiful and mysterious Addison Wade, but he knows he wants to find out. Part of him wants to hate her for what her family has done to his kind, but he can't help but be drawn to the surprisingly charismatic woman. Addison and Spencer set out to find out what happened to Jeremy, but when Addison's secret is revealed things take an unexpected turn. Those she

thought she could trust have betrayed her, and her own abilities may be the difference between finding Jeremy and finding herself locked up with the others like her.

First off, Addison was an awesome character!! She was strong, confident, and not willing to be pushed around by her grandfather's warped morals. As the story went along and Addison spent more time with Spencer, I just loved how bad-ass she became as her powers came to light. She is more powerful than she ever believed, and I just loved seeing her unleash her abilities on their enemies!! She has this air of assuredness about her once she really grasped and harnessed the power within, and I got goosebumps in several of the scenes as I pictured her busting out a can of whoop-ass!! =)

Spencer was such a sexy beast, playing the bad boy but really just a sweet temptation for Addison. His ability to enter the dark place and find the sensations of missing people intrigued Addison, and he's strong and gorgeous to boot!!
