What I liked about this one was that Princess Stasi was a major supporting character, much better linking the original novels. There are even hints of the historical novel McCalla wrote as well.

Minor spoiler- the other great thing was that the bad guys got away with what the good guys were trying to prevent. This might make the pacing a bit awkward to some- there are actually about 50 pages left after what you would think would be the final scene. There is still plenty of action in that last part though so don't worry.

I don't read a ton of mystery, and I knew who should be incriminated. So if you read a lot of mystery you will probably figure that out right away.

The heroine was mostly well written, what I found annoying about her was her guilt she carried around for something she supposedly did accidentally like 10 years ago that her father blames her for ruining the family business. Ruby's dad is kind of a jerk if you ask me and there is no way she should be running back to the US to help him.

One of the hero's internal conflicts was equally vague. Why does he feel inferior to his brothers and feel the need to prove himself to his family? That is obviously a deep psychological issue but we are just supposed to accept it.
