She is sent to Chile by her new editor, who happens to be quite attractive, to win a contest for the cover of their magazine. After several delays, she arrives with her father in Patagonia behind schedule. They are met by Ben, one of the guides, and he hurries them along to join the rest of the group. He is a gaucho and has a wonderful way of training horses.

As the group progresses along the journey, Aurora has more mishaps that are quite funny, befriends a fellow traveler missing her family, and comes across a nefarious situation. Seems like the government and companies are hoping to "develop" parts of geologically unstable Patagonia and the private companies are putting muscle behind the offers of huge money to landowners.
