When readers think there is no other way for the author to create an interesting and arousing sex scene, they are not let down. Patrick opens doors to a world that seems vaguely familiar and sometimes titters toward the realm of fan-fiction. Erotic and romance book lovers can easily point out some similarities to E. L. James trilogy, but don't get it twisted, Patrick is no copycat. With a twist of its own, “Solid Stone” takes off full throttle in an intriguing and unpredictable direction that will have you forgetting about Christian...Who?

As Violet Cole, a paralegal, bumps into the career accomplished Adam Stone, the pair explore and satisfies their sex craved desires as they attempt to define a relationship that is appeasing to them both. But here's where it gets so darn good! Violet isn't this shy and clueless virgin that needs much teaching.
