Repeated Errors Prevent Book From Shining

The story was a tally quite good, although the young woman having sex before marriage could well have waited until after the wedding. My biggest issue was with spelling and words used incorrectly. A comma used here and there would have made reading so much easier. Words such as "too" and "to" are not interchangeable, but appear so here. Full words were left out, "he's " became "she's , commas became a thing of the past, and these errors, that so EASILY could have been corrected by a proof-reader were left in to baffle the reader of the book.
