The Weakest Link is a conspiracy thriller set in the north of England 2012.

In an attempt to decrease the growing negative media attention, a government agency agrees to investigate the origin of a cancer cluster in a small country village. The story reveals the Government's attempt to cover up the cause of the 'outbreak', when, despite all its efforts at concealment, the source is discovered.

The weakest link, is a young, seemingly insignificant woman who, as a precautionary measure, is unwittingly placed onto the scientific investigative team, with the intent of making her a scapegoat should the project need terminating.

As the story unfolds, the lead character finds herself carried along by events beyond her control, pitting her wits against an agency determined to silence her and her colleagues before their duplicitous scheme is made public.

'Because no matter what you do in the future, you can never change your past!'

This is the 'hook line' and the premise of the book centers around secret government agencies, and how they can place people with a past, in situations that can then be manipulated, leaving them as scapegoats should the need arise in the future.

The weakest link in the story is a young woman who is placed on a project as the potential 'fall guy', or is meant to be. If everything had gone to plan, there would be no story.
