I'd have to say that "Calvin", otherwise known as Hunter or Ryan, comes out the worst in this one. He's a nice guy with his friend Cole (whose story is told in the previous book, One Night With Hemsworth) and all his friends...but he keeps blaming the heroine for his sleeping around with thirty-five ish women while they were apart. He doesn't seem to own up to it. And he had her address, and yet, never looked up the girl he couldn't forget. I'm not sure what his reasoning for that was. But not having a decent "why????" Really took away likability points for him.
