When I read the synopsis of this book, it was an automatic “must read” for me. Michele de Winton is a new to me author but after reading The Boss and Her Billionaire, I’ll be checking out her other offerings soon.

No one knows his background and the ship is the perfect place for him to “get away” for the next three months.

Michaela Winters is the only woman cruise director in the company. She’s tough but fair and has a reputation as a task master. She’s also trying to recover from an affair with the captain. When Dylan appears on her ship the attraction is immediate but she has no intentions of getting involved with a fellow crew member again.

It was fun imagining this relationship taking place on a busy cruise ship with the non-stop activity and the very busy schedule that the crew maintains. Because I’ve been on a “behind the scenes” tour of a ship, the description of the staff canteen and living quarters were fairly accurate which I greatly appreciated.

It's there he meets Michaela, the cruise director and his boss's boss. There's an immediate attraction there, but then she states that hanky-panky between staff members is frowned upon. That doesn't stop him though, even when she assumes that he's gay. Obviously the two have to start a love affair, but what happens when Dylan goes back to his real life?

I totally loved the idea of a billionaire (temporarily) leaving his job to chase his long lost dream of being a dancer! Unfortunately, I never bought his reason for going. It's not so much that he needs a vacation, but that his jerk of a brother guilts him into going so that he can work things out with his wife. Because how is suppose to fix things when she keeps running to cry on Dylan's shoulder? It seemed like drama for the same of drama, and to give Dylan a complex about marriage and relationships in general. It was just really awkward and I didn't believe it.

Ms. de Winton's debut takes the undercover tycoon to new level. Dylan Johns has been dragged into another fight between his big brother Brian and his wife Lilly. As usual, Dylan Johns rescues Lily as he has been doing for the past 10 years. Therefore, he makes the decision that Brian, his big brother, will head the company with his mother for the next three months and Dylan will have the chance to live his dreams as a dancer.

Ten years ago Dylan was all set to go to dance school in New Zealand, but Brian's problems meant he went instead to business school and took over the company from his mother and now heads the company in Sydney. He has one clear ideal: no marriage after the firsthand view of Brian and Lilly's marriage which involved a number of mistresses. Lilly would marry him in a heartbeat if she could. His mother and father's marriage wasn't ideal because his father died when he was about eight .

Michalea Western is the only female cruise director on Adventurer Cruises and has worked hard to reach the position. After six years in the cruise industry, she is one step from a head office job but she has one problem. The affair she had with the captain whose wife is at head office. The captain is holding it over her which has lead to 13 months of no sex despite the teasing of Felicity her best friend on board.

As she prepares the staff for the latest cruise and a dancer catches her eye, Michaela is torn: she clearly doesn't want another romance to affect her chances and makes the decision to make an announcement that there will be no romances on board, which the captain doesn't like. She is about to get another dressing down from the captain because she didn't like him taking over when she was about to give her commencement speech. When the dancer she had eyes on comes and save her, it is the start of a beautiful relationship.

The dancer is no other than Dylan who has been hired as part of the entertainment staff and soon is being talked about amongst the dancer team who think he's hot and gay. Enter upright Michaela who is looking in on the full dress rehearsal to make sure everything is all right for opening night and thanking the team when Dylan decides to kiss Michaela on the lips after some dancing.

Boom! Magic occurs and there is growing tension between them, but Michaela is still uptight until Dylan starts to gain the attention of the female passengers and further drags Michaela into his dancing. Michaela tries to deter him by scheduling him to the point that he is pretty much busy all day. One day of this, though, and Dylan comes to Michaela and they both finally succumb to their attraction.

They have a series of problems, try a passenger claiming an affair with Michaela, and Michaela having trouble with the captain and trying to keep it a secret. But when the biggest problem arises with Dylan's family and he leaves without any warning and at the same time Michaela is offered a job at head office, we see the couple going their separate ways ... but will they get back together?

I say this was interesting, in fact, all the recent Indulgence books I've read from Entangled had interesting takes on old storylines or modern updates on the plots. This one was a update on the old rich guy going undercover with a twist. Dylan Johns just did not reveal his true job, but he was honest about everything else in his life. Therefore, I liked the update on that as we usually see the main male character undercover in his own workplace or to get away from it all and going under some assumed name. Same with the update for the main female character—Michaela with her being the boss, which I found an interesting concept and a plus factor for this book.

I have to give the book 4 couples. The reason why I didn't give it a perfect 5 is because of what happens to one character. I won't say who and what happens, but to me it was really obvious. I do like a bit of surprise and this wasn't and the excuse for it—please! was a bit light too. Otherwise, it was a great debut and another book to recommend for category romance fans.
