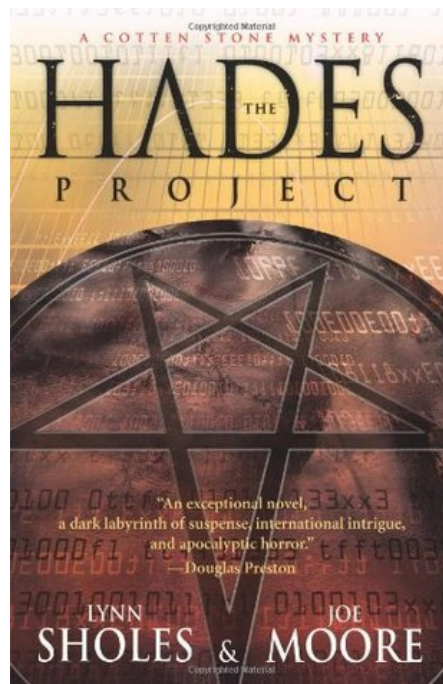




The Hades Project
