Jacob and Elisha are kind of annoying because they go back and forth in their feelings and decisions. They are supposed to be older, but they act really young and immature. With proper editing of the whole story, it could be much better. At times Jacob and Elisha are certain of one thing, and the next page it goes on and on about feeling uncertain and that they are stuck and can't move on, so that was frustrating to read. The story and the characters need to be consistent. Elisha is rich, but she lets her husband walk all over her. She's afraid to divorce because they did not sign a prenup. As someone who came from money, she

would have had resources to get out of her marriage. She's afraid to deal with her husband, yet she keeps fixating on having a baby with someone else? Though she wants a baby to love, bringing a baby into her toxic marriage -and a baby that won't even be her husband's- is a form of abuse itself. It's selfish of her to purposely bring a baby into the world before taking care of her toxic marriage and abusive husband. She's not even that old, but she acts as though this is the only time she'll be able to have a baby.
