I have to be honest, I didn't get very far with this book, and not because the story wasn't gripping, because it was. I received the book for free via Goodreads Giveaways, and was looking forward to getting stuck in. Unfortunately, it seems that the publishers just printed the book as is, without the proofreading and editing process an author expects to receive from their publisher.

These were just some of the issues that stopped me from continuing with the book:

Tense changes - "Perhaps the only thing Kim loved more than her business were her children, Olivia her daughter is twelve while her son Junior is nine."

Homophones - "Only Kim new that he came back after midnight"

It's a shame, because the story itself was good, but the many errors and inconsistencies meant I couldn't continue after the first couple of chapters.
