As some of you may know, Erotic Sci-Fi isn't my usual choice in sub-genre, so this was a pleasant surprise for me. Although there is *some* Sci-Fi-y stuff to this—a bit of world building, language barrier, legalese, and technology advances—the heart of the story is a hard-core DD/BDSM romance. In other words, a tale fit to get my juicy bits juicer ?

A quick note: I've not read the other books in this series, so I have no idea how closely this one matches its mates. It's an intriguing concept to me as an author—individual books written by various authors, but all comprising a cohesive series with each working off of the other. I imagine this created a whole set of challenges. And I just lurve me some challenges when it comes to writing.

Now back to our brutal lovin'....

This review is gonna be all about one thing—*my* alien. **Xan**. He was...wow...where do I begin? At the beginning? Sure...

This starts off with a full-on, no holds barred, non-con. A **lucky** forced Blythe has found herself in the unique position of being awarded her life in exchange for becoming a well-cared for ward on a distant planet. She's unfamiliar with the customs and culture, but she's trained for this/she's a quick learner (er...she better be!).

I particularly enjoyed the non-con aspect of this: the concept of “man” venturing out into the unknown regions and coming across “alien” planets with unique and different ways of meting out justice and getting one to adjust to new surroundings. On the surface, it's an erotic story, but the underlying message reminds me of all adventure tales: bravely going into the unknown and ultimately discovering what lies within. Isn't that what all Sci-Fi endeavors to explore? And isn't some part of that always going to be non-con?

I mean, the alien planet didn't invite an invasion to its land...so....can the invader really expect to be treated to anything less than an equal dose of non-con?? Lucky for me...the answer is NO in this case ?

And **Xan** is particularly adept at non-con. No, seriously. He's damn good at manipulating the whole situation to have his ward, Blythe, positioned, primed, and pumped for his ready use. He also makes full use of his medical knowledge to take Blythe from non-con to dub-con to just plain please-do-me-now....**BUT** it's not the easy-peasy path of some non-con stories. And for that, I'm bowing to the author! (Thank you!!)

No....Xan treats his ward to all sorts of **yummy** strict discipline measures to see that she is quickly, and thoroughly, under his complete control. There is no leniency given, no coddling or back pedaling, no means for anything less than complete submission and obeisance. Xan is all Alpha-alien.

And the slightest sign of anything less than submission and obedience from Blythe is met with immediate punishment ? Oh....maybe I shouldn't be smiling yet...because the punishments are **HARSH**. We're talking electrical shock, ice cubes in places not known to appreciate any chillin, and degrading objectification....not to mention all the spankings which might require a new word for *red* and *bruised*. See why I LOVE Xan??

If you're looking for a sweet alien/earth chick book, then this probably isn't for you. Blythe crash landed on the planet of Prakir, ruining their pretty beach. They took exception to this and sentenced the crew, Blythe included, to be fostered with high security clearance families. Xan, a doctor with military background, is chosen for Blythe because she's proven herself problematic--mainly, she's a biter ?

First, I loved Xan. He was deliciously dominant, and I enjoyed his take-no-shit attitude. Blythe, SMH, was a different story altogether though. Though I liked her more as the story progressed, I found her extremely annoying in the beginning. She continually made choices that didn't make any sense and only made her situation worse. While I can appreciate an author wanting to throw in some lovely punishment scenes, I cannot abide using otherwise intelligent women acting stupidly in order to accomplish it.

Outside of that, it was the inconsistencies that truly prevented me from enjoying this book...and there were quite a few.

There were a couple of problems with the timeline. There's also the fact that they (the people of Prakin) consider the women children even if we (people of earth) do not...

"They're still children--all of them are under thirty-five."

But if this is how they treat children...umm, gross.

The big one that really bothered me--Blythe has a freak-out about him not using protection, worried about pregnancy and STDs, even wonders if her birth control would protect her from becoming pregnant with an alien's child. But later...

"As for being sterile, they told me years ago I'd never have children."

So why the freak-out?

And many, many more. If Ms. Michaels cleaned up the discrepancies, this would be a great little read, though it does end in a 'To be continued...' and we're not warned of that.
