He only brings her charms when she is in danger and needs a special kind of protection. June can already sense the evil approaching her little town of Whispering Falls.

Later that morning a strange man comes into her shop and she senses that he needs a special potion to help him with some troubles. June has the gift of intuition and can sense what a person needs, then she adds special ingredients to lotion or lip balm or simply makes them a special potion to cure them or help with what is bothering them.
