It is well-researched scripturally and but often relies trite clichés and sayings (i.e., you gotta keep on keeping on, he was sick and tired of being sick and tired, when life gives you lemons, etc.).

It is definitely a good starting point for a discussion with one's pastor, a friend, or a counselor. However, the book fails to delve deeply into the presented problems. Instead, it tends to distill the application of lessons into overly simplified lists (i.e., the three R's, the three C's).
