This statement, made by the eponymous character, is just about what you'd know and love from any free-spirited woman: "I know what I don't want, to start with. And cook bacon and eggs over an outdoor fire." That statement encapsulates how well Kate is written, and this character was immediately endearing to me.

Also enjoyable was the clever way the author turns a phrase so that you can understand exactly what she means, such as "a dog who was long in the body and short in the leg," calling up visions of dopey basset

hounds with sad eyes and sweet dispositions.

Lastly, there are little nuggets of golden phrase that make you remember why you started this series in the first place, "If Lettie knew one thing about second-hand reporting, it was that the facts of the matter are usually the first casualty..." Clever.
