Fast forward 16 years and we meet up with Lady Juliette Brooks and she is finally panning her season in which to find a husband. There have been obstacles, neglect by her father-the Earl of Riverdale and a new stepmother that seems to rival Cinderella's. Juliette has tried so very hard to stay in the background and wants desperately to make a match and start her own family. Suddenly she is not having her season and she is promised to a man that sees nothing wrong with beating women for sport.

We meet up with Grayson Abbot and he is now the Duke of Kissinger. While he is a duke and has responsibilities to his title, he refuses to marry. Over the last 16 years he has avoided Juliette because his father threatened her family and he does not know why, even now with his father dead. He had not wanted to end their friendship all those years ago, but was given no choice.

Gray agrees to fulfill his promise to Juliette and they are racing to Gretna Green. During the trip, there they reconnect and renew their friendship. The conversations are fast paced and witty, but not pithy. Ms. Brower has created deeply rich characters in a short time and you are rooting for them to reach their HEA. Being a novella the drama of the relationship and the trip to Scotland are shortened, but you do not feel cheated. Gray's defense of Juliette against the brute was justified, but the result was glossed over and could have had a bit more explanation. There are several things at the end that, while appearing neatly tied up in a bow, were not explained to my satisfaction. Perhaps an addition three or four pages could have added that sense of finality, but I still enjoyed the afternoon read. Ms. Brower is a new to me author and I am looking forward to more historical romances from her.

Juliette was about to remind Grayson of that long ago promise. Her situation was dire and only desperation would allow her to contact Grayson again, since he didn't seem to feel the same connection by his silence all these years. What lets this particular book down though, is something that definitely should have been picked up during the editing process. Almost every time a section of text starts with a piece of dialogue, the initial " is completely absent, meaning you often don't realise someone is speaking until you're part way through their conversation. This ruined things for me as it made reading it horribly hard work. So much so that I didn't even finish it.

A charming Regency romance novella with an extremely likable heroine, Dawn Brower draws us deep into her characters' world from the very first scene of *A Wallflower's Christmas Kiss*. Gideon and Juliette are an adorable couple even as children; their separation is clearly devastating, though more so for Juliette, when she is left behind as Gideon is sent off to Eton. Fast forward fifteen years and a grown-up Juliette turns up on Gideon's doorstep asking him to honour the promise he once made, that he would help her if she ever needed him. Promised in marriage by her distant father and a stepmother who wants her gone to a lord with a reputation for cruelty, the only way Gideon can possibly protect Juliette is to make her his bride. A hasty dash for Gretna Green ensues before Juliette's disappearance is discovered.

I thoroughly enjoyed this story and I only wish it was longer! I'd have liked to know why Gideon's father was so set against Juliette's family, and I'd have liked to see her stepmother forced to grovel for the new Duchess's forgiveness (wicked stepmothers should always have at least one grovelling scene, in my humble opinion!) Christmastide wedding + nine months of pregnancy does not equal "you will be a father in the early summer" this is a math + biology fail that rather threw me at the very end of the book.

Still, Juliette and Gideon made a charming and believable couple; Juliette's feistiness was wonderful and she would definitely spend their marriage leading him around by the nose. While this novella is part of a series it stands very nicely on its own and you do not have to have read the rest of the series to thoroughly enjoy it. I'll be looking forward to reading more of Dawn Brower's books. Four stars.
