Book 4 Faren and Leiya

This is the 4th in the Brion Brides series.

Alien Warrior's Mate: While I read pretty much everything, I'm normally not a big fan of the sci-fi genre, however Vi Voxley is definitely an exception and is one of my new favorite authors! The book was very well written, and I always look forward to seeing more from this author. The only reason for the three stars, instead of the four I otherwise would have rated it, is because of the sadness of Urenya losing her first fated mate. Even though she hadn't really known him, I still found that to be really sad and put a taint on the book I didn't care for. But that's just a personal preference, and if that kind of thing doesn't bother you, than I'm sure you'll enjoy the book.

I first read book six in the Brion Brides series, then picked up this bundle and am so glad I did! I loved it, couldn't put it down, missed a lot of sleep and can't wait to begin book five.

Some observations: The bundle book order is off chronologically, as it begins with book three (the longest) then book four, one (SS/novella) and two (SS/novella). Since I started with six, that wasn't an issue for me. But if you are new to the series, you may want to read them in chronological order. Also, the black color option for this bundle on my Kindle presents a totally black page, no print is visible. The lighter color options work fine, however. Sentence structure and punctuation had me rereading some, but that also wasn't a major issue because I enjoyed it so much. What I didn't enjoy so much was the initial silliness of the heroines in the series order books three and four. That was overcome as the story progressed, possibly maturation under fire?

Overall, this is a set I recommend and will put on my reread list. It is a 4.5 star KU Library read.
