I admit, my love for the relationship between Dex and Sloane grew slowly, just like it did between them, and once they proclaimed their devotion, that's when I was totally caught. The connection, the intimacy, the blatant need for each other, just simply did it for me.

However, nothing comes easily for these two. Throughout this series, the struggle for peace between humans and the shifter populations of Therians is what drives the plot every time, and of course Dex and Sloane get caught in the crosshairs. Harsh truths come to light here, threatening them professionally and definitely, personally - all of which leave many unanswered questions. They must be a strong front together as a new evolution (figuratively and literally) is uncovered.

After being very disappointed with Book Six: Catch a Tiger by the Tail (see my review), I was very please that Smoke & Mirrors was back to the excellent story telling I've come to expect from Charlie Cochet. If you've read Book Six you probably remember it ended with a cliffhanger. Smoke and Mirrors begins when Catch a Tiger left off, with Dex a prisoner being interrogated. He keeps being asked just one question, "Where did his mother hide the file?" Of course Dex has no clue what "file" they are asking about. During his interrogation and eventual torture, he learns what he has always suspected, his parents death was no accident.

After his escape, Dex and Sloane set off to discover the truth about John and Gina Daley's murder. But things are changing. Their relationship. Their team. Their jobs. Their friends. But most of all, Dex is changing!

First the good. The plot is excellent. The drama and tension starts building right from chapter one. There is really never a let up in that slowly building tension. The relationships between the characters continue to develop and strengthen. This lead me to become more and more attached to the characters than I had before. The sexual encounters between Dex and Sloane were exciting and well written. The conclusion was rewarding and exciting because it provides the possibility for more THIRDS books or another series.

The bad, personally I love the gay male characters. They are strong gay male role models. They work in a difficult job and perform above and beyond expectations. But then so often you find them with their heads on someone's shoulder crying. It seems like such a contradiction. For example, could you see Dwayne Johnson putting his head on Vin Diesel's shoulder and having a good cry? Yeah, I didn't thing so. Do I think it could happen? Sure under the right circumstances. I just think it happens way too often in the book. As flaws go, it's easily overlooked.

→ THIRDS Destructive Delta Agent Tech Expert, **Cael Maddock** (27?), Dex's adoptive little brother and a cheetah Therian. **Rosa Santiago**, his human partner and Destructive Delta's crisis negotiator and medic. Both Recon agents.

→ **Rafe** (the oldest brother), Team Leader for Alpha Ambush and Tiger Therian and **Sebastian ‘Seb’** (middle brother), ~~Agent for Theta Destructive~~ newly promoted to Team Leader for Theta Destructive. Was once on Destructive Delta but was transferred after his relationship to Hudson ended in a breach of protocol and civilian loss. Is a Tiger Therian. Both Hobbs’s big brothers. We learned in book six that Rafe has gotten the Therian Acheron Syndrome as their father..

→ Dr. **Nina Bishop**, THIRDS Destructive Delta’s medical examiner and a human. Rafe and Nina are together.

→ Dr. **Hudson Colbourn**, THIRDS chief medical examiner, and a Canis Lupus (wolf) Therian.

→ Lieutenant **Sonya Sparks**, for THIRDS Unit Alpha and a Cougar Therian. Partner to human Tony. Sparks is part of TIN—Therian Intelligence Network; as an undercover operative. Sort of the Therian version of the CIA. They exist, but technically they don’t. Austen, the SSAs works for them.

→ **Louis ‘Lou’ Huerta**, Dex's ex-boyfriend of four years.

→ THIRDS Agent **Ellis Taylor**, Team Leader of Beta Ambush, and leopard Therian.

→ THIRDS Agent **Levi Stone**, Team Leader of Beta Pride, and white tiger Therian. Got arrested for being a mole inside the THIRDS and part of the Ikelos Coalition in book three.

→ **Osmond Zachary ‘Zach’**, Agent for Alpha Sleuth in Unit Beta and brown bear Therian. Has six brothers working for the THIRDS.

→ **Bradley Darcy**, bartender and owner of Bar Dekatria and Jaguar Therian.

→ **Austen Payne** (23? 24?), Squadron Specialist Agent (SSA) for Destructive Delta and a Cheetah Therian. Is a undercover freelance operative for TIN (Therian Intelligence Network).

→ **Angel Reyes**, Member of the Order. Former member of the gang Westward Creed.

→ Dr. **Abraham Shultzon**, was the head doctor during the First Gen Recruitment Program who was personally responsible for the wellbeing of the THIRDS’ First Gen Recruits. He was also responsible for the tests that were run on the Therian children. He was recently (book five) apprehended by TIN for creating an

unsanctioned Therian mind control drug, and for kidnapping THIRDS Therian agents for unsanctioned project.

→ **Arlo Keeler**, Ash's twin brother killed during the riots in the 1980s.

→ **Beck Hogan**, a Tiger Therian and leader of The Coalition. Dead: Fell to death.

→ **Drew Collins**, a Cougar Therian and a part of The Coalition; Hogan's new second-in-command. Dead: Ash snapped his neck..

→ **Felipe Bautista**, was Drew Collins's boyfriend of ten years and a wolf Therian.

→ **John Daley**, Dexter J. Daley's biological father. Anthony Maddock's best friend, and partner at the HPF. Killed during a shootout in a movie theater during the riots. Human.

→ **Gina Daley**, Dexter J. Daley's biological mother. Worked for the CDC in NYC. First to volunteer to work with Therians. Killed along with her husband during a shootout in a movie theater during the riots. Human.

→ **Darla Summers**, Calvin Summer's mother. Human.

→ **Thomas Hobbs**, Ethan, Sebastian, and Rafe Hobbs's father. Suffers from Therian Acheron Syndrome. Tiger Therian.

→ **Julia Hobbs**, Thomas Hobbs's wife, and mother to Ethan, Sebastian, and Rafe Hobbs. Human.

→ **Benedict Winters**, THIRDS appointed psychologist.

→ Admiral **Abbott Moros**, Chief of Therian Defense. Tiger Therian.

→ **Mr. Wolf**, a wolf Therian who called himself Mr. Wolf, but that's just one of many aliases. He's a freelance professional. One of the best.

Smoke & Mirrors is the 7th book in Charlie Cochet's *THIRDS* series. It's been such a fantastic ride getting here and I think this might be my favorite book, so far. Fans of the series won't be disappointed.

The story hits the ground, running, with Dex waking up tied to a chair. And if you've read *Catch a Tiger by the Tail*, then you know his predicament is not the sexy kind. Nope.
