Twisted Rose is the third book in a very dark series.

The story picks up immediately after Tainted Rose and I was looking forward to see how Rose's life would pan out and see if she'd ever truly get free of the DRMC. I struggled to get involved with this book. I found the writing style annoying and repetitive and the sex scenes clumsy. For me there wasn't enough interaction between the characters or much dialogue and we spent too much time in the characters' heads.

I struggled to make it through this final instalment but it was worth hanging on to get to the last 30% or so of the story which I did enjoy.

The Darkness Trilogy is harsh read and there is not much light in the darkness.
