Three Threads of the Story - Unique

The way the author put the story together was unique to me. While not necessary to follow the story, I highly recommend you read the prior 2 books in the series. The prior 2 books will have some details that will make following the storyline easier. The basic story is about two people, a male bear shifter and a female police detective who meet following a grizzly murder. The bear shifter is a person of interest given he shows up on the day of the murder, and matches the murderer's description. Throughout the story are excerpts from an

interview done at some point in the future with the bear shifter and the detective regarding the events around the murder investigation. Additionally, throughout the story are excerpts from an article written from the interview notes. So we have the story told from 3 distinct points in time: 1 as they occur and told by the detective, 2 as they are told to the interviewer, and 3 as they were portrayed in the article written by the interviewer. The interviewer's focus is on the shifter aspects, not the murder investigation. I can also see where the author is going with a hopefully fourth book in the series. This story was not a cliffhanger; you will get a complete resolution. But as with life, there is always another street to explore right around the corner. I look forward to the journey.
