"Midsummer Night's Mayhem" is the third book in "A Sister Witches Mystery" series. Lauren Quick casts Clover Mayhem as the leading sister in this magic filled story. Clover is seen as least successful of the Mayhem sisters by the outside world. She lives in the rural community known as the Meadowlands in the home that belonged to her aunts. Every solstice for the past eight years she's thrown a party for her family, friends, and neighbors. This year is no different. As a word witch, she can weave together great stories that come to life for her audience using advance illusion magic. (Kind of like holograms in Star Trek.) Clover uses this magic to entertain her guests and to hand out prize money to a less well off witch. When Oliver, her neighbor, starts to poke around her home during her party, they exchange words before he storms out to return home. But he never makes it.

Much to Clover's dismay, she finds his body.

Thrown into a formal investigation, the local police department have to search not only her property, but her house as well. Clover has a closet filled with her writing materials associated with her pen name Clarissa Reason, that she doesn't want anyone to know about. Instead of coming clean to the sheriff and his deputy, Clover and her personal assistant, Austin, do everything in their power to solve Oliver's murder. But will it be enough to save her secret identity, or will the world find out what she's really capable of doing.

Overall, I found this novel to be fairly good. I downloaded it as a free copy, and read it first by accident. There was minimal confusion on my part since Quick does a good job going over the basics of her witchy world with her readers in each novel. I didn't agree with the way Clover and Austin handled the situation with the police department. And on the flip side I would of thought that Vivi could have given her sheriff boyfriend a heads up about the whole Clarissa Reason part of Clover's life in an unofficial manner. I know he's a "by the book" kind of guy, but still it was a bit much. And I know that Clover was deathly afraid of anyone finding out her huge secret. But come on, who has a personal assistant unless it has something to do

with their job anyway? In addition, her whole reluctance to share what's in her closet was going to go into public record. So I think that would make everyone distrust her, look down on her, and/or wonder what she's hiding.
