Rowen Greensmith's boyfriend, Eric, purchased a small newspaper business for her. She and some of her cousins run the paper and online blog. Eric is a businessman and works out of town most of the time. His brother unexpectedly shows up at the Greensmith home late one night, destroying their newly planted rosebush because he was drunk. His brother, Eric, and parents come to town to deal with his unruly behavior and possibly involved in the recent murder.

Rowen's cousin, Margo, and Eric's brother, David, become romantically involved. Eric and David quickly become household members of the Greensmith's home.

A local woman is found surrounded by occult material after she was murdered. Rowen works closely with an ex-boyfriend, Ben Williamson, from high school, to discover who murdered the woman. Through a maze of twists and turns, the reader is shocked when the culprit is revealed rather abruptly.

There are a few grammatical errors. But all in all, it is an interesting piece of entertainment combining humor, paranormal activity, and mystery. This book is able to stand on its own, it is a clean read, and they solve the mystery of who murdered the woman and set the scene so bizarrely. There are sure to be more mysteries in the future.
