This is a sweet story of an unlikely friendship that seems will last forever, until it's time to say goodbye. When Little Bot gets thrown out with the trash, he wakes up in an unknown place. Sparrow, curious about the little machine, befriends him when she sees that he needs a little help in this environment. They go off together exploring the forest as the seasons change. When winter returns, Little Bot has to say goodbye to Sparrow, but he continues to remember everything they did and what he learned from his little friend, including how to dream. Young readers will love the soft illustrations and simple writing. Aside from introducing the seasons, this book is perfect to talk about friendships, and saying goodbye.
