I like the author a lot. Everything I have read by Hornbuckle has been well written, polished. That said, I didn't like this book all that well. That is certainly not to say it wasn't well written but rather than I didn't like the hero much at all.

Mel is from Hiding in Plain Sight. He is brought to the city and to the Hellions as a recruit for the MC and a trainee for the Construction Company. He is only 23, and while he is mature in some ways (seen mainly in his interactions with his younger siblings), he has a lot of learning to do in relationships. In the start, he is attracted to Lulu (who is 25 by the way and more experienced), but he doesn't value her much and learns that plainly as he goes from her right to a threesome with two Honeys the very next day. Of course, Lulu finds out about this. Honestly though, he didn't think much of it, except to be happy that two beautiful women wanted him. He was very very young in terms of that, blinded by becoming part of the MC and the women. He had some growing to do for sure. That just isn't my favorite hero, hence my lower stars on this book. Even in the last chapters, he just seemed wishy-washy on his heroine, still with a lot of growing to do.

Lulu was better. She had already started to come into her own, and had a good personality. Thankfully the conflict between the Honeys and Lulu was kept to a minimum in this one. Any conflict was due to the hero and not really the Honeys. I just honestly wish Lulu had had an older, more stable, stronger hero to match her spunky personality.

On to the next book though, and I will continue the series. It is motorcycle club light in that nothing too horribly nightmarish is described, and the club is on the legal side of things, having their construction company as their main revenue, though they dip into other sources of income as well.

Like the previous book I liked this one too, even both the hero and heroine here were different from the one's in the previous book, they were still amazing.

Lulu was cute in a way iconic and unique, because since she left her family, and gained her independence, she pushed to gain her *true self*. I liked how she was with Mel but I felt sorry for her most of the time, first because of Mel then because of her dad. she was a strong heroine, but her strength was of a different kind
