Yes, it has the makings of a typical, cliché historical romance.

But I enjoyed it immensely that I metaphorically gobbled down the book, going waaaaayyyyy past my bedtime. I was deeply entrenched in the MCs' thoughts; I just wanted to understand what they were thinking, why they did what they did.

I like how the backstories of the MCs were well developed that you could see for yourself how the past events in their lives shaped them to be what they are today. How the oppressed Melinda feels that one has to fight for what one believes in, how the treatment she gets for being a bastard translates into empathy when she sees another child being treated that way, why cuckolded Miles feels such great jealousy and anger when he sees Melinda near any other men. How they feel, why they feel that way, all were with valid reasons; not merely used as a tool to drive a plot towards the direction the writer wants to go.

The only drawback is that there wasn't a clear indication whenever the perspective change. I was reading on my Kindle, and at times I lost track of whose perspective I was reading.

To Kiss a Rake mostly revolves *Miles & Melinda* as a married couple and the walls they have to break down together, erected between them by their individual pasts.

We are all shaped by our past, how we were treated when young and other experiences in life. Melinda was must the hoyden from a family that valued conduct. Her family had an impeccable pedigree and she had to toe-the-line or be severely punished. Miles, on the other hand, came from a family who had flaunted proper conduct and was considered a rake from his past foolery. Rebecca, Miles's illegitimate daughter, touches your heart strings as she already has a good taste of what is
