A trainwrecky romance novel that will fit in perfectly into modern HPlandandia !

If it wasn't for the different cover and publisher, I would swear that I'd just finished reading a Harlequin Presents novel. This story has some the key HP ingredients that go into making the HP template:

A vengeful studly Greek billionaire hero.

A goodie two shoes virginal, martyr heroine who will do anything for her amoral, conniving identical twin sister.

A private Greek island setting.

A forbidden relationship that's due to mistaken identity (because the H thinks the heroine is his little brother's sideline girlfriend)

This was a surprisingly entertaining story for me and I really wished I'd not forgotten that it has been on my *currently reading* shelf for a few months now. If I'd started it, as intended months ago, then I would've definitely finished it quickly !

Leah, the heroine, is a 20 something yr old high school History sister whose identical sister, skanky Susie, is a famous pop star. At first I found it unbelievable that the H (and the rest of the world) was unaware that skanky Susie had an identical twin, but the author explained very logically how that all had been a deliberate part of the twin sisters' parents' plans. The storyline is based on Leah's impersonation of Susie. The heroine has been conned by Susie into believing that the H is out to destroy her (Susie) and prevent her from marrying his younger brother Spiros. The truth is less palatable: Susie is a promiscuous drug addict who owes a lot of money to an Italian drug cartel. But, she's used her awesome acting skills to fool the heroine into believing that she's a sweet, innocent victim of paparazzi slander. Skanky Susie is also obsessed with the hero ! The H is Alex Kristidis, a billionaire tycoon. He loathes Susie because she had once bribed hotel maids to let her into his penthouse suite, where she got naked and tried to tempt him to sleep with her. Alex, who thought she was just a promiscuous teenage tart, threw her out of his suite and she's been obsessed with him ever since. She's latched onto his meek and controllable brother Spiros because she wants to find a way to get back revenge on the H for refusing to sleep with her.

But now, Susie is a woman scorned twice over because Spiros dumped her for his Greek fiancée Elena. The scorned Susie had lied to Spiros and told him she was pregnant just so that he would marry her. The H found out about it when Spiros said he'd have to dump Elena and marry her for the unborn baby's sake. That's why Susie begged the heroine to impersonate her; Susie fed Leah a pack of lies and asked her to act as a decoy so that she (Susie) could elope with Spiros. Leah cuts her hair and starts dressing like Susie so that the H's detectives would fall for the decoy. It worked so well that the heroine ended up being kidnapped by the H and taken to his private Greek island. Leah was also lucky that Alex's detective had been following her, because he saved her when Susie's drug dealer friends drugged her and tried to kidnap her at gunpoint. The bulk of the story takes place on the private Greek island where the heroine continued to pretend to be her sister, while fighting off the H's sexual advances. Alex, for his part, is surprised that he is actually attracted to her since he'd always felt revulsion for Susie. In fact, the first time he kissed her (to prove to her that "she's" not in love with Spiros), he's filled with a mixture of confusion and raging lust:

Alex was also caught up in the confusion. Why did he suddenly feel this magnetic attraction to Susan? He'd kissed her to prove her attraction to him, but instead of leaving a bitter taste in his mouth, her lying lips were sweeter than honey. His tongue darted out of its own volition, eager to delve into her mouth and explore every ounce of sweetness that it offered. She was so soft and sexy. His need to feel her pliant nakedness against his own hard strength was almost as unstoppable as responding to a siren's song. It was no wonder Spiros was attracted to her.

Of course, the storyline follows Harlequinland patterns because the H only finds out she's not Susie after he takes her virginity. He knows she can't be her sister because his detectives had acquired many photos of shanky Susie having sex with various men. There was a nasty argument where the H says some very vindictive things to Leah, before rejecting her love and throwing her out. He's another one of those alpha Greeks with a brooding tortured past. His issues are all due to his dead promiscuous adulterous mom and his alcoholic, gold digging late wife who'd lied about being pregnant just to trap him into marriage. The H figures out he loves Leah 2 days after he'd kicked her off the island and then he's thrown into turmoil when he hears that she's been hit by a truck and is in the ICU. Fortunately, it had just been another case of mistaken identity and it's really skanky Susie in the ICU. That made me so happy ! Lol. In the epilogue, the MC's are married, the heroine is pregnant and Susie is a drug free spokesperson for the Anti-Drug campaign. And the cheater Spiros is married to the long suffering, sweet and passive Elena.
