This 20 something, victim of leukemia (oh, BTW, I had not read any of the other books in the series, I was given this one in exchange for an honest review, so I went back and grabbed the FIRST book in the FIRST series to get some background) was given the option of dying with dignity in Hospice, or going to see one Dorian Thorne. Black writes them so well, that they do not make you want to throw your kindle, but re read the story to see if you missed something because you were so engrossed in the story. Time without end is the second installment of Cora's Bond, the continuation of the story of Dorian and Cora from Cora's Choice.

In this installment Cora and Dorian are working on their bond/relationship. We were left at book 1 with them being chased by a Djinn and all the rules of the agnate and congate world being broken as cognates are sacred and never harmed. Dorian's character is growing as he is becoming in a word more animated after centuries of not having a cognate that helps him to be more human. We also find out he has a daughter from a previous cognate and delve a bit more into his past. Cora is growing by leaps and bounds as she is tossed into a world and relationship that is overwhelming, overpowering, and tempestuous.

This serial is one of the best stories I have read. The world itself is fresh and the characters and the interaction overwhelming. The cliffhanger in this one is well perfect.
