They provide a ton of great backstory and will make everything a lot more understandable, and without a doubt enhance your enjoyment of this book as well as the entire series.

Spell for Sophia provides plenty of tension and action, actually a lot more than I expected. There's always something going on-either in Sophia's or in Ainslie's parts of the world-so you're constantly on the edge wondering what's going to happen next.

One thing I love about this book (and actually the whole series) is how accepting these young teens are of the magical world. It would be expected since young teens are naturally more open-minded and willing to believe.

I was actually expecting most, if not all of this story to be played out entirely with Sophia and those immediately around her, so it was a pleasant surprise to have Ainslie and the rest of the characters from the first books play a greater role, and it really helped tie the stories together even more tightly, giving the entire series an increased feeling of connectivity.
