It was okay but not up to the level of her others. Rafe is the rogue cowboy who ribs the other guys for being tied down with a filly. Modesty is the innocent rodeo princess he met over 6 months ago and shared a steamy kiss with before she ran off. Now she's back to the ranch to help her friend, Dallyce, plan a wedding.

I had to re-read a section because I thought I somehow skipped them actually having sex but, nope, it was written that way. If you blinked you missed their entire first time together and Modesty's first time ever. I don't think the word virgin should be in the title if it's not important enough to work through in the book. There was a brief discussion the day after the deflowering but that was it.

I enjoyed this book. It was interesting and I liked the characters. It was a short, quick read. Modesty and Rafe met in the first book of the series when the Rodeo Princesses were staying on the ranch. They had some chemistry but when they kissed the intensity scared Modesty and she pushed Rafe away and nothing was ever explained. Now Modesty is back on the ranch, running from something and the chemistry is just as strong. Modesty is a little better at dealing with it. Mia Madison is back in the saddle with this third book in the Foxworth Stud Ranch series. The last one was a bit of miss for me, but I absolutely loved this one.

Rafe is a rough and raw cowboy, set in his bachelor ways. He's watched a few of his buddies settle down recently and swears that the committed couple life is not for him. Rafe is good looking enough and built enough to have the female guests of the ranch falling at his feet for some of his special R & R and why would he ruin a good thing by limiting himself to one woman? Besides, he doubts that the uptight city women are going to stop having their hot, sexy cowboy fantasies anytime soon and he's happy to make those fantasies come true – for one night.

Modesty is friends with Dallyce (from book 1 in this series) and she's headed to the ranch for some respite after a devastating break up. The last time she was on the ranch she and Rafe shared a hot kiss that she's never forgotten, but Modesty also didn't forget his cruelty when she decided that she wasn't ready for more than just kissing yet.

Rafe hasn't changed. He's crude, gruff and a player. He's much older than Modesty and WAY more experienced than her, but he can't help but feel protective and possessive when he's around the young beauty. Modesty is still looking for the right guy to punch her V card, but Rafe's made it clear that he's not the guy for that job. The snarky and snippy back and forth between Rafe and Modesty was funny and hot and really built up the sexual tension between the two of them.

Although Rafe is determined to stay single, the arrival of rodeo queen Modesty back on the ranch puts paid to that thought rather quickly.

My main annoyance was that a winning formula isn't enough to cover for slapdashery. Plot points are tossed in randomly, and the primary twist in the story came from nowhere. Also, instalove works best when the characters are seen making changes and sacrifices...but these two don't. There's a lot of longing and misinterpreted glances, but not much more.
