With this collection Wrath James White peels back the scabs on modern society to reveal the raw, seeping putrescence underneath. This is not comfort reading or something to unwind with after a stressful day; this is an unflinching portrait of mankind at its lowest, which White bravely and accurately details with painstaking precision.

In ten stories and two poems White presents enough murder, necrophilia, sexual extremism, and self-mutilation to reel the mind of the average reader (though it's a safe bet anyone opening this book's beautifully grotesque cover can't be considered "average") with his no-holds-barred, straight-to-the-gut style. Happy endings are few and far between in the world White depicts, yet he often gives us an understanding of people and places we'd never dare visit on our own.

LIKE PORNO FOR PSYCHOS comes in at a mere 87 pages, though after ingesting the stories within it becomes apparent that the abbreviated page count is an act of mercy (one of the few offered here). The book can be a bitter pill to swallow, but as life often teach us, the most valuable lessons are the most painful.

I cannot unsee some of the graphic images contained within this book. I've read a lot of extreme horror...an awful lot; this is something else entirely. I've been on a bit of a Wrath James White fix recently for reasons I cannot explain. Perhaps there is something about his deranged, sexual storytelling that strikes a nerve, or perhaps I've been looking for something to shake me up a little after being a little desensitized with some recent stories I've read. Like Porno for Psychos certainly did that. Not one of these stories takes a backward step, in fact, they seem to get even more crazy the further you delve into the book. This book was hard to put down. The collection was so seamlessly compiled that you start to find yourself trapped in Wrath James White's depraved little world. It's hard to get out once you're in. It's not haphazard like some other collections and each story flows effortlessly from one to the next. Not to mention you constantly find yourself NEEDING to see what the next tale brings. You NEED to see what White will do next. Each of the stories themselves are highly inventive and would make today's Hollywood Horror standards cry in shame at how stale and tired the genre has become.

If you're unfamiliar with White, he's a hardcore/extreme horror author along the same lines as Edward Lee. Well, just replace Lee's grossness factor with eroticism and a little less fluid. Expect a lot of sex and gore with a subconscious commentary on the human psyche. Expect cannibalism, skin being flayed and depravity. You'll need a shower after this one.

In this short collection, sex and death collide in ways that do not so much bleed as they haemorrhage imagery that is both enchanting, disturbing, sickly humourous and slyly political. Themes of admiration and empowerment for women, outsiders and the put-upon are woven throughout these gut-wrenching stories - there is as much passion and love for others here as there is a fascination with the extremes of gross-out and what the human body can endure. And these studies in extremity sometimes cross the usual boundaries for horror into the realm of the metaphysical - the conclusion of 'Like Peyote for Pimps' being particularly noteworthy here and the closing lines of 'After The Cure' will be staying with me for a long, long time. This is powerful stuff. You should check this collection out.

I guess it really doesn't need to be said that this is an extremely hardcore book, first it's Wrath James White and second it has some of Suzzan Blac's brutal/beautiful artwork. What comprises this collection is extreme erotic horror as only Wrath can do it, ten stories bookended by two pieces of poetry(Before you say "I hate poems", remember who wrote them!)

If I had one complaint it would be that I wanted more, at a page count of 87, I easily devoured Porno it in one sitting. Other than that minor gripe, it's easily one of the best horror collections I've read in quite some time. Below are some of the stories that stood out in my opinion:

Like Peyote For Pimps- Someone or something is eating the sexual organs of G- Town Slim's stable of prostitutes. Pimpin' aint easy, but this time it's murder...

Feeding Time- Sandy has a very peculiar sexual fetish, it involves fantasising about being mauled and having sex with lions. She's not crazy enough to try it out is she??? Without a doubt my favorite story!

Nothing Better To Do- Freddy's bored and that damned dog needs to die! But could it be a thousand year old demon that can command people to do anything??? Has the unfortunate meeting between a penis and a cheese grater...I better stop there...

After The Cure- Finally, a cure for all sexual diseases including A.I.D.S. is released to the public via shots from your local free clinic. Now that sex is safe, the entire world begins having sex with wild abandon. Unfortunately for everyone who took that shot, there is a very deadly side effect....

Consider my curiosity appeased. **Porno for Psychos** was my first Wrath James White read, born from the blurbs I'd read in the back of several of Brian Keene's Deadite Press releases. I'd wondered if he was as extreme as those blurbs made him sound (almost), pondered if he could be more disgusting than Edward Lee (no), and mused over whether such writing could be enviable in its construction (most definitely - because there are some fantastically written passages found within these pages).

That said, I'm not sure whether this series of short stories and two poems constitute horror. They are certainly disgustingly debaucherous, and as the title of the collection implies, positively pornographic. But despite all the gender mutilating and ass reaming, none of the stories elicited any thing more than the occasional shudder of repulsion or a disgusted curled lip from me. This largely explained why I found the collection to be just an okay read that was easily devourable. You know, like genitalia (if you're a Wrath James White character) ...

High points: FATTER, JOY and KIDS.

Low points: FEEDING TIME and AFTER THE CURE.
