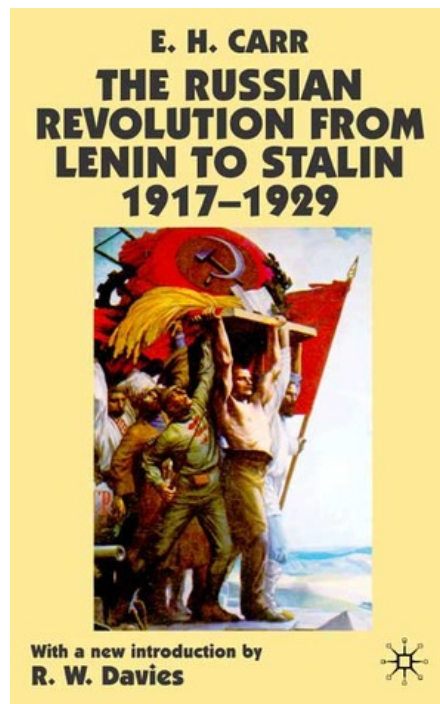




The Russian Revolution from Lenin to Stalin 1917-1929

Es imposible comprender la historia del siglo XX sin conocer la historia de Rusia. La Revolución de Octubre de 1917 inició un fenómeno casi sin paralelos en la historia contemporánea cuando un país asumió la teoría revolucionaria marxista y se embarcó en el proyecto de encarnar un país socialista pero con el notable obstáculo de partir desde un puerto política y económicamente atrasado: la Rusia zarista.
