I remember the first time I saw the cover of this book clearly. It was in one of the reverse harem facebook groups, I was scrolling looking for updates from a few of the authors I'm particularly keen on and I stopped looking at this cover and instantly followed the pre-order link knowing this was a book I had to read. I didn't even read the blurb at that stage instead wanting to dive in blind.

Natalia finally sees her mob boss Father commit one too many crimes and runs, straight to a church where she thinks she will be safe. Except in that church pretending to be Priests are a team of mercenaries who just happen to be hunting her Father.

Hawke, Arsen, Weston, Colt, and Mace may well be the fire they talk about when people use the saying jumping out of the frying pan and into the fire. They are cold, ruthless, and in Arsen's case insane. Staying with them may seem like the safe choice but it is likely she would be safer in a pit of viper's.

Natalia's relationship with them is fraught and uncomfortable but heated as she explores her sexual desires vs her personal feelings. These men just want information and they have no trouble using her to get it. I loved the darkness in this relationship, this wasn't a romantic story where we are waiting to see a happy ending. I was just hoping everybody got out alive and unscathed.

Five Fathers is a stunning reverse harem which gave me everything I LOVE in a novel like this, but it is definitely not for people who like candlelight and roses served with their books. This is a dark romantic suspense with not a lot of romance!

Natalia ran. After witnessing a terrible trauma Natalia finally ran from her mob-boss father. Desperate, high on cocaine, she ran into a church begging to become a nun. Having little religious knowledge, she chose a church based on appearance, vaulted ceilings, stained glass windows. Once inside she found it was unlike any other church. It was housing five hot "priests". They are undeniably dangerous, crazy, insanely attractive. Everything that appeals to Natalia.

Five fathers is a sinful read; provocative, sexy, entralling, disturbing. It is addictive. Five mercenaries posing as priests on a mission to kill the local mob boss. When Natalia, the daughter of the boss unknowingly offers herself up to the men, they must decide how they want to use her; turn her against her father or hold her against him. They don't realize how the little spitfire will get to each of them or how they can end up hurting her even more than her father is capable of. They can offer her heaven or give her hell. Natalia is seriously messed up. She's damaged. Her greatest fear isn't dying, it's being caged. This explains so much about her. She self-medicates and uses sex to numb her loneliness, to make herself feel alive, to get her father's attention. She is self-destructive and strangely attracted to deadly, disturbing men. Hawke, Arsen, Weston, Colt, and Mace all fit her specific needs. Hawke is cold, Arsen is insane, Weston and Colt, deadly, sensual, and each with a touch of humor, and Mace, soft-hearted (for Natalia), a mountain of a man, complex

Mace. Each man brings a new temptation for Natalia. It's seriously steamy.

The book is written in dual POV which works incredibly well with this cast of characters. It's great getting into everyone's messed up mind. This is not a sweet, sedate afternoon read. It's intense, a grab you by the balls and never let go thrill ride. It's a little obscene, with just the right amount of filth. I desperately want more. I may need to go to confession after this one...
