Damn. Forward was quite a ride. I was impressed by Lara – her voice was tremendously appealing. Witty, feisty, extremely relatable. Even when I was getting annoyed at her for s\*\*\*-shaming her coworker, she immediately scorned herself for it, which was really cool – you don't often see that in romance novels. I like the fact that the author didn't fall all the way into the “all other women are skanks and they're awful!” trope, 'cause I hate that.

From the first page and the first signs of conflict, you're convinced that Lara's feelings are genuine. You believe in her confusion. You certainly feel her devotion to her career. And while the opening scene sets you up for bad news about Tom, their relationship builds and grows throughout the book until you don't know who to root for! I will say, I was Team Tom for 98% of the story. Levi came off as a creepy stalker in the beginning, and then I thought he was super manipulative and frustrating and just urghhh. A few things kept me from giving this book 5 stars. Something really didn't sit right with me about Levi's reason for leaving. The explanation was sound in terms of giving him a foolproof excuse but...I don't know. It seemed like it belonged in a suspense or thriller novel instead of a romantic novel? The story was so rooted in reality that to suddenly be hit like WHAM with this wild, action-packed, craziness put me off a bit. Not that things like that don't happen in real life (sorry, I really don't want to spoil the book for anyone!) – but it just didn't seem to “fit” in the story. It was too foolproof, if that makes sense. No loose threads – and real life is full of loose threads! And it comes back at the end with a real WTF moment...I don't know. I just wasn't buying it.
