But lately, things are not so perfect. Eric has shot a man in the line of duty. Doubting his action, his convictions, and ultimately his whole purpose in life, Eric is a man looking for redemption and absolution.

Angelica Vega owns a bakery. Nicknamed Angel, this perfectionist in her work however has a wild side she has indulged in quite a few times in the past. But Angel has always known something was missing, this 'spark' that could fulfil her. After two break-ups in her store, Angel is struck by lust the minute she lays eyes on the detective assigned to the case – Eric Neal.

We start off in this book about 2 months after the incident that happened with Eric shooting Rodney Baker in order to save Lucy's life.

Eric is still struggling through the horrible dreams of ending another man's life. even in the line of duty and knowing it was to save Lucy's life. But a life was a life, and Eric was having a really hard time dealing with it.
