### **Sweet and decent if unspectacular Omegaverse rescue story**

This sweet and decent Omegaverse romance has the typical elements of this genre - a big buff wolf rescuing an abused Omega as well as some smexy knotting, mating, and mpreg. Overall, it was nicely diverting and escapist if not particularly spectacular or enticing. Also, it had bit more of the masculine dominant /abused-feminine-submissive stereotypes and "gender" roles than I prefer. While these roles are very common in the Omegaverse subgenre, other works often challenge/undermine these stereotypes a bit more, whereas this was more of a buff, gentle, but also sometimes "in control" dominant rescuing an abused omega who doesn't want to submit, but eventually does (due to a mixture of biological heat and a the firm but gentle nature of the dominant wolf).

### **Interesting and engaging**

Seth and Caleb were an interesting choice to pair. Seth is an omega who ran away from his pack out of his fear of being mated and used as nothing more than a pup dispenser. Caleb is a gamma whose mother died in childbirth with his younger brother. This experience left him with the conviction that he never wanted to mate and experience that pain. And yet, these two shifters are drawn to one another so intensely that they both question their earlier convictions.

My favorite aspect of their mating was the fact that, while each began to want more, many of their decisions to mate were actually based on very pragmatic factors. Neither Caleb nor Seth went into this mating with rose colored glasses; they each expected nothing more than a marriage of convenience from their situation, but they found love, passion, respect, and hope.

Like all the other books in the series, this was a great read. I loved the relationship between Seth and Caleb from the start. It was so tender and nurturing that the warmth just captured my heart. I really like stories where the omega is delicate and his partner is strong (physically and emotionally), yet very caring. Caleb believes that he can be Seth's mate and take care of him without losing his heart, but we know that it's been claimed from the start. Seth has come from an abusive and very controlling pack, one he'd rather die than be a part of anymore. He can't believe that a high ranking male (in Caleb's case a gamma) would provide for him without wanting to be serviced in return; it's up to Caleb to show him that compassion and caring comes with no strings. As with the other omegas in the series, the heat and pregnancy comes very quickly. The question is whether the couple has or will move beyond their reservations and be more than just mates of circumstance. This was a truly sweet story. My only complaint was that, like the others, Seth is just beginning his pregnancy when the story ends (although we did get Joey's delivery from the last book). This device keeps us reading on to the next book to get the couple's complete happy ending. As long as the books stay so entertaining, I'm perfectly okay with that! Also as a note we get a peek at the other omegas as they surround and support Seth. I really love this pack and enjoyed catching up with everyone. New members are on the horizon as well so we have plenty of opportunities for more stories.
