This book, while it is a love story, and it -does- have a happily ever after... It is also a story of self discovery for our heroine, Cat, though. While the book is well written, and peppered here and there with things that will make you burst out laughing, it will also run you through a gauntlet of emotions.

*30 Lays in 30 Days* is the story of Cat, an almost 30-year-old who just came out of an emotionally abusive marriage. In an attempt to take charge of her life and all of the things she missed out on, she makes a list of 30 sexual escapades she wants to happen before her 30th birthday.

The first escapade she reaches is a one night stand with a total stranger. She meets Jackson in a club and boldly asks him if he wants to *fuck*. Going through that is what sets her list in motion. She goes through a bunch more things on her list: sex with a celeb, sex with a woman, sex in a public place, sex with someone from high school, and sex with someone in the military. When she lands on sex in costume, she gets more than she's bargained for, and almost gives up the list altogether. Instead, she flees to Jackson's apartment and comes to the conclusion that she just might be starting to have feelings for him.

The rest of her list is concluded with Jackson as her partner, until her ex, Richard comes back. He attempts

blackmailing her with her sick father and his care. You're heartbroken for her because you want her and Jackson to be together so badly, but know that there's no way possible for that to happen with what Richard hangs over her head. Until she not only gets back at him, but she gets even.

This story has a little bit of everything in it: love, sex, revenge, friendship, and conflict. I wasn't sure how I would feel about it. I knew it was going to be very sex-fueled - how could it not be with the title *30 Lays in 30 Days*? - but I didn't expect the love story hidden within. Cat and Jackson are such a believable couple, almost from the first time they're thrown together. It's hard not to root for them to make it out together in the end.
