This is a free prequel for Paige Tyler's **X-Ops** series (which I really like).

This story gives you a quick romance and a bit of backstory on the characters you'll see coming up. Cree is a fox shifter and is meeting John for an interview. He's had her in his sights for a while and wants to recruit her, except she's more than she seems.

The story is primarily the two of them talking and connecting, and through their conversation you learn about what's going on in the series as a whole, which is why I recommend reading it once you're already one or two books in.

Many reviews have mentioned not liking how short it is, but really it feels like a teaser. If you read this, you'll be hooked enough to go into the series. However, I think it's a good idea to read one of the full-length books first. It stands alone, but you get more out of it if you've already started the series.
