Noelle is just your average woman. She is a school teacher living with very little in the way of luxury, but that is all about to change when a handsome stranger walks into her life. She is drawn to him, unsure if it is his good looks, that damning smile or some other unseen thing that pulls her to him. But she gives in.

The attraction is instant, but Gabriel is holding back. He must confess some dark secrets before he can move forward with her. Noelle is suddenly thrown into a relationship with a man that is the anonymous lead singer of Darkness Falls and man that has a deep need to control. She has never had much experience with sex. But Gabriel is bound to push her to the edge of her limits to expose her to the darkest parts of her mind.

As she is opened up to his lifestyle, a place where the lines are blurred between pain, pleasure, reward and punishment - she sees that this man seeking such control is horribly broken. To say that this was just a glimpse into a dark place is an understatement. A man who is seeking control of others because he had no control over what happened to him. A man seeking peace for himself by giving his demons to someone else to carry. He will break her to save himself. He will find

his salvation by finding the one person who breaking will be his damnation.

To say this book destroyed me is an understatement. This was not expected - this shattered me with one knock on a door. With three words written on the top of a page. A statement. A truth. Three words that brought me to my knees.

This book dives into the dark world of BDSM when a man uses this as a coping mechanism for his own pain rather than for a place to find pleasure. He will use and abuse his control - her willingness to please him.

When I finished reading this book, I felt a bit like this:

I went from liking, maybe even loving the story, to being confused and growingly frustrated by how things played out. I had this freebie on my Kindle for a while and I was intrigued by the blurb and while I'm still glad I decided to give it a try, the ending didn't exactly leave me satisfied either.

Here's what I liked and didn't like...

What I liked:

► **Gabriel** - He was the perfectly imperfect, tortured hero. Granted, he came off as a bit of a stalker at first, but I quickly got over that and started to fall for his mysterious bad boy ways. Experiences from his past made him always want to be in control and I think that was the biggest source of frustration between him and Noelle. Being dominated isn't something she's used to and it took a lot of time for her to surrender herself to him.

► **The writing style and editing** - The author has a way of catching your attention and making you engrossed in the story before you even realize it. I really enjoyed the way she wove the story together and how the two main characters came to meet and get to know each other at the beginning, right up until the final few chapters.

► **The first 65% of the story** - From alternating POV's we follow Gabriel and Noelle as they meet, get to know each other better and start a quickly developing passionate relationship. They're very different, she being a sweet innocent school teacher and him being a depraved rockstar/public enemy number one, but it was interesting to see the two of them together and I was rooting for them to get their HEA.

What I didn't like:

X Noelle - At first, she seemed like an okay heroine, but as the story went on she started to annoy me more and more. I couldn't connect with her in any way and the decisions she made didn't make her very likable. She came across as selfish and a bit aloof and I actually felt sorry for Gabriel because he kept pouring his heart out and she never fully returned his feelings.

X The last 35% of the story - From here on out, the story went downhill for me. I began to have this sense of dread and a suspicion that something bad was going to happen and well...I was right. Somehow, the story also lost my full attention and I wasn't as enraptured with it as I was during the first half so when the "big revelation" finally came it didn't affect me as much and it also didn't come as a complete surprise.

She's a strong female character which I love, but I honestly didn't see how Noelle and Gabriel could have a lasting relationship. Really she made smart choices concerning their relationship, if your not completely comfortable with the situation then don't jump to commit to it. I got that but at some point in this story I began to blame her for Gabriel's inability to become the man I hoped he would be. Before I begin my review I want to make it very clear - do not compare this novel with 50 Shades of Grey. It is inevitable that it will be and yes there is the working class girl and the rich man but that is where any similarities end.

Ivory Quinn's novel takes us on a very different journey of domination, subversion and manipulation. This is no Cinderella story and it could be argued that it is not a love story either but you can also argue that love comes in many facets and for Gabriel Hallows it was multi coloured. The story contains sex multiple sex scenes and bondage.

The author introduces us to the idea of cognitive dissonance - the theory that suggests that if an individual acts in such a way that contradicts their beliefs, then they typically will change their beliefs to align with their actions (or vice-versa).

The synopsis sums the story with "Gabriel Hallow is a damaged man. Rock star, producer and public enemy number one, he sees his redemption in quiet, wholesome school teacher Noelle Winters. Crashing into her life like a wrecking ball, he smothers her innocence and leads her down the razor's edge between submissive and victim, opening her eyes to things she didn't even know could happen between a man and a woman. Overwhelmed by his generosity and charm, how far will she go to save his soul? And when is it too late to turn back?"

I don't think that this scratches the surface of the contents of this story. There were times when I felt such sorrow for Gabriel and there were times I felt disbelief and anger.

When Noelle Winters bumps into Gabriel Hallows little did she know that day would be the day that Gabriel Hallows begins the process to possess her and so begins her descent into the darkest parts of her human psyche. She had no idea who she had literally collided with - the lead singer Darkness Falls. All she sees is a face that was made for sin.

For me this book wasn't just about their relationship, it was also about their personal struggles - Gabriel's inner struggle trying to find redemption and Noelle's struggle trying to come to terms with her acceptance of her submission and what she allows Gabriel to do to her.

For a debut novel this author impressed me with her plot and characters - there is nothing subtle or graceful about them. Their story carries a lot of emotion and Ivory Quinn delivers quite a sting in the tail towards the end of the book one that I did not see coming,

I don't think any kind of blurb can get you prepared in readiness for the content of this book, it's raw, evocative, mesmerising, dark, colourful, very hot, uncomfortable and just absolutely riveting. But heed the warning in the synopsis, it is dark and lots of bondage and you're catapulted into a world of manipulation and the dark areas in a human mind.

Gabriel, oh my what a tortured man he is. One minute you'll love him and then you'll kinda hate him for what he exerts over Noelle, his dominance and control is forefront 95% of the time and yet he captures you and like a deer in the headlights, you can't help but be drawn in.

Noelle, she's funny, clever, naive, an all round good girl. Then she's caught up in Gabriels world, introduced to things that horrify her and yet intrigue her. She finds herself questioning herself a lot.

One of the things I loved about this book was the conversations between them, she didn't hide her questions and her concerns and they spoke freely about them.
