I love the odd relationship between Mafuyu and Takaomi. With Takaomi gone a lot of this volume it wasn't as fun, though the moments he had were hilarious. Love the boys love tones when Mafuyu plays her male alter ego Natsuo. And his bizarre explanations for why he does things - though he does look like Yakuza.

Hayasaka and his desire to be as good a fighter as Mafuyu/all her alter egos is quite fun - love that she

attempted to teach him some of her blocking, etc techniques. His relationship with Mafuyu is perhaps even more complex than hers with Takaomi as he has a clear desire to protect her.

Mafuyu is so fun because being a disciple of Takaomi growing up she knows so much about being a leader and she teaches the guys around her - like Yojimbo's leader and how he needs to trust his men. The first section had the student president Miyabi setting up Mafuyu and Hayasaka for a major fight with another club. Mafuyu goes undercover as the male Natsuo in order to be able to fight, and tries to teach Hayasaka some actual fighting techniques. In the end, Mafuyu figures out that she can't just protect the people she cares about, she has to trust they can take care of themselves, too. It was sweet, though, that Hayasaka was so worried about Mafuyu and wanted to save her. And Mafuyu's reaction to that was adorable. :)

The next story brought Mafuyu's former #3, Maizon, to town to deliver some cookies from the gang and to see her. He ends up running into Hayasaka and Kyotaro first, who are positive this gang leader Mafuyu he is looking for can't be their Mafuyu. Their search for this mighty leader leads them to have hilarious adventures about town. It was an interesting little chapter, but I wish we'd seen more of Mafuyu in it.

The last section had Takaomi dragging Mafuyu off to the beach to blow off steam, where we discover Mafuyu can't swim. Takaomi tries to teach her, and then gets mad when she almost drowns. And apparently he gives her CPR and saves her. Though a lot of their interactions is him teasing her, I think deep down, Takaomi has real feelings for Mafuyu. Hopefully they keep coming out!
